Major revision: The Authors writed in the "Introduction" that, in addition to the hands, sacroiliac joints are used for evaluation of rheumatoid arthritis with conventional radiography. This datum should be clarified, because imaging of sacroiliac joints is indicated for the evaluation of ankylosing spondylitis and spondyloarthropathies in which those joints can be involved.
