I would like to communicate now some minor observations concerning the manuscript in order to contribute to the improvement of its quality: - From my point of view you could be more specific in the title to be consistent with the manuscript contain. The text explains essentially "dislocations" so the title should reflect this. Present title is more general about "SCJ Joint injuries" - Format note: Headings of text should be left aligned. Please see instructions for format. - You wrote in the keywords section 'physiotherapy'. However, in the manuscript I miss information regarding the approach of physiotherapy for these injuries. Please, provide specific information or remove this key word from de list. Maybe replace for "surgery"? - Please, define the meaning of the abbreviation "CCL" (page 11) first time. - In the REFERENCES section, considering the author guidelines of the journal of formatting, please: http://www.wjgnet.com/2218-5836/g_info_20100724203243.htm o First author surname in bold. o Journal title abbreviated in italics.
