SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is an excellent manuscript on an important topic. My only comment is that preparations for fatherhood must vary substantially among countries. I believe there are still many countries where it is the mother's full responsibility to look after children. Therefore, I think it would be important to specify what part of the globe the various cited studies come from and whether the recommendations would apply equally well in all parts of the world.
