COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The manuscript is well written though it could be shortened, there is a redundancy in the theme that 2 step delivery should be utilized more, otherwise it is a great and comprehensive review of the topic. There are several minor comments bellow: The methodology used is not described in this manuscript, rather the reader is referred to previous description in previous publication by the author - to me it took more than 10 minutes to get this information, I would expect the authors to add abbreviated description of the methods used. Can the author provide reference to the last 3 sentences in the first paragraph in the section DEFINITION OF SHOULDER DYSTOCIA. The author state that fractures of the skull is relatively frequent - can he add reference? In the section EFFECTS OF PRACTICE PATTERNS, subsection Electronic fetal heart rate monitoring- the entire paragraph related to internal scalp monitoring and its possible role in infections - us irrelevant and should be deleted. In the same section the subsection dealing with epidural anesthesia is to simple and needs elaboration and more details.
