This is a brief overview of the complication, graft versus host disease, that sometimes occurs after stem cell transplantation. The article is fairly well written, yet improvement in English is definitely needed. Another point of note is that the discussion on secondary malignancies includes studies involving patients with stem cell transplantation instead of just patients who develop GVHS after transplantation. These discussions seems irrelevant to this article and should be trimmed. It'd also be an improvement if the authors could include clinical images of patients who develop GVHS. I'd recommend publication of this article if the authors are willing to amend their manuscript as recommended.

It seems that authors well organized the information from clinical papers and guidelines of GVHD recently published. However, this manuscript still has the minor problems before acceptance for publication. 1) This paper needs English revision, because some words and sentences sound like Portuguese or Spanish, i.e. P4, Line 9; (40 a 70%). Also there's a nonsensical sentence in the manuscript, like P5, Lines23-27. 2) Please use the all abbreviation after definition when it first appeared. HPV and EBV in P7, Line 9 should be defined here. 3) Are the strip preparations appeared in Fig. 2 and 3 original? Please provide the information and magnification of these sections.
