## COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

General comments: This is a comprehensive review about adherence to immunosuppressor in renal transplanted patients and includes the latest and educational information in this aspect. Specific comments: 1. Abbreviations should be defined on the first mention in the text. The author did not provide full spelling of the following abbreviations on the first mention: HRQoL, QALY, PPY, PCS, MCS and RTRs. 2. The author described "et al." in most points but "et al" in some in the text. 3. page 7, line 22-23: No conjunction is found between two sentences. 4. page 10, line 24: "QUALY" should be changed to "QALY".
