The focus of both papers is on medical humanities and psychiatry in coping with the consequences from COVID-19 pandemic. The views, presented by the authors are interesting and balanced. However the pandemic leads to a variety of foundational transformations in the very definition of mental health and mental disorder, with a significant frameshift towards more liberal understanding of values implicated under COVID 19, e.g. values comprising coherence and quality of life.
