## SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

I carefully read this paper, and I believe the issue the author is researching is very important. Research on thermal burns is crucial, and the associated psychological health problems are even more significant. However, while reading this editorial, I identified a few issues. First, there is no apparent structure to the entire text. There is a high level of repetition between different expressions, and the amount of information covered is insufficient. Second, the author did not provide a perspective on the relevant research field, which is a critical aspect for an editorial.
