In this study, the authors investigated the anesthetic nurses' cognition and management experiences of emergence delirium. The data were collected using a semi-structured interview method. The interview was conducted according to the semi - structured interview guide. The findings are interesting, and well discussed. Overall, the manuscript is well written, and is acceptable. The reviewer recommends to accept this study after a minor revision: 1. The manuscript requires a minor editing. Firstly, the format should be updated according to the journal's guideline. Secondly, some minor language polishing should be corrected. 2. Too many subtitles in the main text. Please try to shorten the subtitles. 3. References list is updated, but requires an editing.
