The author wrote the current situation of fostering, and suggested that the need and value of male adoption is underestimated. The author attempted to prove that single men are successful to be a foster parent as well as women. This manuscript seems not to have major flaw in its concept and logic. The author wrote that childcare agencies



are not actively recruiting men. But is there any evidence to confirm it? Or, is it an estimation of the author? If the latter, rather social hesitation, or discrimination, is rather responsible for sluggish spread of male adoption, in my sense. Are there any data about the acceptance rate of male candidate for foster father?
