Figueiredo et al presented this interesting review article about solid organ transplant in Jehovah’s witness recipient. Subject is of interest and is well written. I have few minor comments. Please include appropriate citation for important points- eg : “The use of RhEpo is particularly useful although patients must be aware of the risks associated with



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infusion, including the risk of sudden death."- this statement need appropriate citation along with many other important statements. Under plasma derivatives, would mention which are commonly accepted and not accepted by JW's eg- cryoprecipitate, fibrinogen concentrate etc. Would summarize various options pre-and post solid organ transplant in flow chart/figures for all 3 cells ( RBC, WBC and platelets). If possible it would be worth mentioning what is the prevalence of WJ's in each solid organ transplant and is it increasing or decreasing in the current era, compared to the past?
