It should be less than 12 words. 2. The running title less than 6 words should be provided Abstract 3. Line 9: "suPAR" should be changed to "soluble urokinase type plasminogen activator receptor (suPAR)" Text 4. No headings provided. Headings should be added such as "Introduction", "Biology of suPAR", "Summary", et cet. 5. Put reference numbers in square brackets in superscript at the end of citation content. 6. page 8, line: "FFSG" should be changed to "FSGS" References 7. PubMed citation numbers (PMID and DOI) should be provided to the reference list when available. 8. The reference number 48 and 49 are the same articles. Please delete no.49.
