COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This manuscript investigated outcomes of TB treatment and analyzed factors for unsuccessful TB outcomes in rural Nigeria. The manuscript is basically well written. Although this study has some limitations as authors stated in Discussion section, the findings are useful to improve TB treatment outcomes in area similar to rural Nigeria. I just give some suggestions below. Page 1. Title. Page 11, lines 9, 10. The description has inconsistency with Table 1 data. According to Table 1, 520 (47.3%) were treated using the 6-month regimen. Page 11, line 16; Page 12, line 4 from bottom. Add a comma (,) before "respectively". Tables 2, 3. Check the format of the figures and use only one page for each table if possible.
