NGS can rapidly identify specific changes in DNA sequences and detect multiple targets simultaneously, such as amplification, deletion, tumour mutational burden (TMB), and microsatellite instability (MSI). The National Comprehensive Cancer Network (NCCN) guidelines (version 1 2022) have affirmed the value and significance of NGS in the treatment of gastric cancer. However, we need to inform patients that the use of NGS could lead to few clinically meaningful responses. We think that patient and their doctors may jointly decide to order a gene panel at no additional cost from the public health care system.
