Some suggestions may improve the article. The fulltext does not properly reflect the meaning of the topic. Some of the content is similar to popular science, and is suitable for the general public rather than professionals. Some of the literature appears old and incongruous, while some of the more recent literature has not been cited. The 37th reference is misquoted. It should be "Sada A, Yamashita TS, Glasgow AE, Habermann EB, Thompson GB, Lyden ML, Dy BM, Halfdanarson TR, Vella A, McKenzie TJ. Comparison of benign and malignant insulinoma. Am J Surg. 2021 Feb;221(2):437-447."

We have updated and modified the manuscript according to the reviewer's suggestions.

The reference has been corrected. Moreover, newer literature has been cited.
