Scientific Quality: Grade C (Good)

Language Quality: Grade B (Minor language polishing)

Conclusion: Minor revision

Specific Comments to Authors: Postmenopausal bleeding and thickened endometrium in menopausal women indicate the presence of endometrial lesions. In this study, a total of 187 postmenopausal women with bleeding or asymptomatic thickened endometrium underwent diagnostic hysteroscopy. The authors found that diagnostic hysteroscopy is recommended based on its lower cost, lower rate of complications, and high accuracy. The study is well designed and the results are interesting. Minor comments: 1. The manuscript should be edited. Some minor language polishing should be revised. 2. The results are well discussed, however, the authors should also discuss the limit of the study.
