Reviewer: Hypothermia is the most common complication of rapid mass blood transfusion, and it can induce or aggravate the degree of shock, including several complications such as postoperative chills and restlessness, which affect postoperative recovery. Predictive nursing interventions are preventive for possible adverse reactions or states of patients to prevent or reduce adverse reactions. In this study, the authors explored the impact of predictive nursing intervention on the stress response and complications of women undergoing rapid mass blood transfusion during cesarean section. This study is overall well designed and the findings are interesting. Comments: 1. The manuscript requires a minor editing. 2. The limit of the study should be discussed. 3. The references have to be edited and updated.
