I must congratulate the authors for their efforts in writing this manuscript. Esophageal duplication cysts are a rare entity encountered during surgical practice, authors to share pre-operative radiology images including those of CT neck if done. What is the biopsy report? Detailed intra-operation photo if available.

Reply:

1. We did not perform a neck CT scan on the patient before the surgery, so we cannot provide the radiology images.
