"For early detection of perforation, it is necessary to check the patient's condition immediately after ERCP. If the patient complains severe abdominal pain, abdominal X-ray and CT are good methods to identify ERCP-related perforation. If retroperitoneal air is visible during the procedure, abdominal X-ray and CT are also useful."

(2) Some abbreviations are not explained.
