- An audio core tip file has been attached.
- Reference numbers changed to superscript.

Reviewer 1

Regarding comments from the first reviewer, mild clarifications have been added to the “Case Presentation” section, in response to his inquiries. Frozen section was not performed intra-operatively, during the initial operation, with an already mentioned final pathology/diagnosis of the resected mass; despite the compression from the mass on the right middle lobe bronchus, resection was not attempted, as patient was, otherwise, asymptomatic, and also taking into consideration, her financial status.

Reviewer 2

For the same reasons, stated above, no resection of the compressive mass was performed, given the asymptomatic course, and patient was unwilling to proceed with surgery, given her financial obstacles.
