Response: We have included information regarding the patient's VEGF status in our revised manuscript.

Response to Reviewer 2's comments.

1. This study is a case report. Therefore, the problems of bias and potential limitation are inherent. Of course, the conclusions must be interpreted with extreme caution. Some suggestions and conclusion are exaggerated.

Response: Thank you for this comment. We have included the following sentence, “**Although the study of additional cases is necessary,**” before concluding with, “MMP-3 seems to be more sensitive to RS3PE syndrome symptoms.”

2. MMP-3 is multifactorial. Important previous papers therefore should be listed in the Reference section.

Response: We have updated our manuscript with references regarding RS3PE syndrome and MMP-3.

3. Images are important for journal readers. Replace them more fine and informative ones.
