As to comments of Reviewer #1

1. “Most patients”(Page3, line3) has been changed to “Some patients.”
2. Regard to “malignancy” (Page6, line16), histopathological findings has been described in detail and the figure of FNA cytology is added. Therefore, the figures are re-numbered.
3. Regard to “metastatic malignancy” (Page6, line22), histopathological findings has been described in detail and the differential diagnosis including primary squamous thyroid carcinoma has been made in the discussion part.
4. Regard to “malignancy” (Page7, line3), it is squamous cell carcinoma and this is confirmed by biopsy. (Fig. 5A) has been added at the end of this sentence.
5. “(Fig. 5)” (Page7, line5) has been changed to (Fig. 5B-H). Fig. G and H are newly added to make the differential diagnosis more clear.
6. Figure 5 B-H has been presented by high power field. Arrows are used for clarity.
7. This misspelling of “hematoylin” (Page16 line 3 of figure legend of Figure 5) has been revised.
