1 Scientific quality: The manuscript describes a case report of the euglycemic diabetic ketoacidosis induced by a sodium-glucose co-transporter 2 inhibitor that prompted the diagnosis of fulminant type 1 diabetes mellitus. The topic is within the scope of the WJCC. (1) Classification: Grade B; (2) Summary of the Peer-Review Report: This is an interesting case of euglycemic diabetic ketoacidosis induced by a sodium-glucose co-transporter 2 inhibitor. Although it a well-known complication of this group of drugs it is well written; and (3) Format: There is 1 table. A total of 16 references are cited, including 3 references

published in the last 3 years. There are no self-citations. 2 Language evaluation: Classification: Grade B. No language editing certificate was provided.
