Rather, it can be judged that proper wound treatment such as debridement and antibiotics helped wound healing. Please insert some details in your discussion.

Thanks for your comments. Indeed, we also believe that “proper wound treatment including debridement and antibiotics indeed facilitated wound healing in clinical practice” and we have added this statement in Discussion Section. Besides, we inserted “Lack of negative control, proper wound treatment might play an important role in CGF therapy on lower-extremity chronic refractory wounds.” in Discussion Section as the limitation of this study.
