**Specific Comments to Authors:** The author presented a rare case of a small bowel obstruction caused by a jejunal secondary tumour from RCC which could benefit for. Although the manuscript was well-organized and well-written, novelty remains the foremost important aspect for a case report. As the author said in the discussion part, there has been a report on the small intestinal metastases secondary to renal cancer which included 15 patients with different symptoms, the author should put more emphasis on introducing novel aspects of the patient evaluation, investigation, treatment, or any other aspect related to patient care.

**Answer:** Thanks for your advice. We have added in the manuscript some clinical points about small intestinal secondary tumors from renal RCC, including patient evaluation, accessory examinations, and treatment options, to promote the novelty and help readers better understand such diseases.
