**Reviewer comments:**

*In this work the authors report a rare combination of EMP of the genital tract with cervical cancer. The latter, as common cancer, may cause an underestimation of the case diagnosis. In this case, Zhang et al. made use of screening with vaginal ultrasound, enhanced MRI and classical immunohistochemistry stainings to further examine the patient's local lesions. Though the English writing is quite a lot improvable, the case is well described, concise and very easy to follow. Thereby, this reviewer suggests its publication in World Journal of Clinical Cases.*
