1. It was not known the exact medicines used for 9 days following the first surgery as the patient was treated in the local hospital and the part of information was not prescribed, but the chemotherapeutic agents were not used at that time.
- 2.The specific regimens of chemotherapy (EMA-CO) was introduced and marked in red in the paper (in lines 107-111)
3. The adverse event is described and marked in red in the paper (in lines 124-125)
4. The detail of  $\beta$ -HCG was discussed (in lines 166-169) and marked in red in the paper
5. The description of lung metastasis was in line 117-120 and marked in red in this paper.
