1. Time after the last menstruation period

The patient stated that her last menstrual period was 13 days before admission. I have added this information in the part of “History of present illness” in revised manuscript.

2. The patient had no history of pelvic inflammatory disease or pelvic surgery.

I have added this information in the part of “History of past illness” in revised manuscript.

3. In the histopathology section, the authors should clarify that other differentials were excluded including hydatidiform mole.

Histopathological investigation revealed chorionic villi within the mass, with no features of abnormal trophoblastic proliferation, which confirming the diagnosis of ectopic pregnancy and excluding other differentials.
