This is an interesting study about the efficacy of ultrasound-guided pulsed radiofrequency combined with the ganglion impar block for treatment of perineal pain. In this study, 30 patients with perineal pain or coccygeal pain were included. The ultrasound-guided puncture, block and pulsed radiofrequency treatment are described in detail. The follow-up data were recorded. Overall, this study is very designed and the results are very interesting. A minor revision is required. Comments: 1. A minor language polishing should be corrected. Such as: page 6, line 95, “Fulow-up” should be “Follow-up”. 2. Some abbreviations should be spelled out. 3. Please add some subtitles to the results section.
