(1) The biggest difference of case 1 and case 2 is level of serum HCV RNA in the re-treatment. Is the reason why case1 achieved SVR because it is low virus loads (less than 5 log IU/ml)?

As you might expect, we guess so. We had mentioned the possible reason in the first paragraph in the section of "Discussion".

(2) It has a large number of reports that patients with low virus loads achieved SVR in short-term treatment. Author should consider that treatment more than 72 weeks is necessary for patients with low virus loads.

We are afraid that you mean that author should consider that treatment less than 72 weeks is necessary for patients with low virus loads. We agree with you. We changed the last two sentences as the conclusions.
