In page 2, introduction section, desmoid tumor is written as a “benign” tumor, with mortality rate near 10%. Usually, such tumor could not be defined as benign lesion. In addition, proper citation is not provided for the mortality of desmoid tumor. In the evaluation of imaging studies, tumor vascularity is important for differential diagnosis. Such information is not available in the manuscript. Figure 3 also lacks the information about the phase of contrast enhancement. Result of immunohistochemical analysis must be presented in additional figure. In page 6, discussion section, they mentioned that immunostaining of the  $\beta$ -catenin is efficient in distinguishing DTs from other lesions. To my knowledge, nuclear  $\beta$ -catenin staining is a characteristic feature of SPN.
