(1) Sentences have been corrected to exclude misleading facts:

- "Oxaliplatin has single agent utility, but it does not".

This sentence has been changed to "While 5-fluorouracil used as single agent in patients with metastatic colorectal cancer has objective response rate around 20%, the administration of combinations of irinotecan with 5-fluorouracil/folinic acid or oxaliplatin with 5-fluorouracil/folinic acid results in significantly increased response rates and also as well as improved survival

- "there are limited sensitivity of CRC to cytotoxic agents". Compared to Breast Cancer, sure, but this is true of most cancers. Many cancers have far less drug sensitivities than CRC. This doesn't make sense.

This sentence has been removed.

(2) The information about mechanism of action of drugs has been shortened.

(3) The suggested summary containing routine clinical setting, barriers and studies going forward has been added to the paragraph titled "Future direction".

(4) Typing errors and a style of English have been corrected.

(5) The Introduction section has been shortened.
