We are grateful for this important comment by reviewer 00289609. We have now provided more background about necroptosis signaling and RIPK1/RIPK3 in the necroptosis section of the revised manuscript according to the reviewer's suggestion.

- (2) *One more section is added to discuss switch/crosstalk among cell death signaling pathways and therapeutic potential of targeting multi-death signaling pathways in cancer treatment.*

We have added an additional section dealing with crosstalk between cell death signaling networks. Furthermore, possible multi cell death targeting approaches for colorectal cancer treatment are discussed in this new section of the revised manuscript.

- (3) *On page 9, line 7, "is" should be "its" (anti-EGFR antibody cetuximab exerts is antitumor effect).*

The typing error mentioned above has now been corrected as the reviewer suggested.
