(1) For this reason the title sounds quite generic and could be more focused on the particular part of prevention as not all of existing approaches are discussed in the manuscript.

Thank you very much for your important comment. We have revised the title for including all contents in this manuscript as much as possible.

(2) I would recommend Authors to adhere the structure to review article requirements with logical coherence. Also it might be recommended to pay more attention to discussion of clinical aspects in the general concept of management of transplantation patients, to discuss diagnostic, predictive markers for patients stratification and therapeutic choice. Contraindication and adverse effects of discussed prevention should be included to the discussion.

Thank you very much for your comment. To resolve the disconnection of the paragraphs, we have moved forward the part of 'Why is the control of HBV difficult? — the complicated HBV life cycle and weak immunological response in chronic carriers' (Page 6, Line 1-Page 7, Line 5). And we have added the aspects that the reviewer mentioned as much as possible.
