(1) In line 1-3 of Case Report, revision as "A 69-year-old man was admitted due to intermittent colicky abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting-----." was suggested.

(2) In line 3-4 of Discussion, "gastrointestinal stromal tumor" should be deleted, "GIST" is OK.

(3) In the Discussion, I think it is more suitable to describe as "The preoperative diagnosis of gastroduodenal intussusception is not difficult, but imaging modalities such as CT, MRI, EGD and EUS only offer preliminary diagnostic information for the etiology [8]. Schwannomas are easily misdiagnosed and frequently as GIST---".
