- 1) We have made the required changes.


- 2) The reviewer 03552056 suggested discussing some references (HERACLES TRIAL, ICECREAM TRIAL, Dienstmann R et al. Cancer Disco 2015; 5: 598-609) and including some tables that recapitulate the clinical trials and agents in research to overcome resistance to anti-EGFR.
- 2) We have provided the information and table required.

- 3) The reviewer 02531403 suggested elucidating the inclusion and exclusion criteria of the studies discussed. He/She also suggested to define "targeted medicine" rather than "precision medicine" in the introduction and to quote studies about the role of chemoprevention and diet in the setting of EGFR mutations
- 3) We have elucidated the inclusion and exclusion criteria of the studies discussed and we have changed "target medicine" instead of precision medicine. However, we did not find studies about the role of chemoprevention and diet in the setting of EGFR mutations.
