We will try to clarify all the issues raised in the emails dated January the 15th and 19th, as follows.

## Reviewer#1

A few diagrams and table are definitely needed for this article, for example, a diagram to show the composition and interplay of GM-immunity axis; A table to show the characteristic composition of GM in healthy, CRC, and postoperation CRC persons; A diagram to depict the three pathogenetic models for happaing of GM-immunity dysregulation in CRC, etc.

**R**. As rightly by the Reviewer, we have added a Table (the Table 1 - showing the characteristic composition of GM in healthy, CRC, and post-CRC surgery patients) and three diagrams (the figures 1 displaying the interactions between the healthy or dysbiotic microbiota and immune system; figure 2 displaying the three pathogenetic models involved in colorectal cancer initiation and promotion and figure 3 illustrating some examples of how microorganisms promote the cancer).

Be careful about the bacterial taxonomy, for example, the writing for the family genus, strain of bacteria.

**R**. We thank the Reviewer for the suggestion. A check was performed throughout the documents and corrections were made.

The abbreviation list is not properly selected.
