Figure 4a A cystic-solid mass was seen with the naked eye, with soft texture and inconspicuous tumor capsule. its cut surface is polycystic, with yellowish jelly-like substances inside cysts, and the cyst wall thickness is 1mm-12mm. No cirrhotic changes were observed in the peripheral liver tissue
