<u>Answer:</u> We added the dose and total duration of montelukast and the partial elemental diet in the "Treatment" section.

### Reviewer #3:

Specific Comments to Authors: Dear Authors, this is a well-written manuscript, presenting an interesting case of a rare condition, which is the eosinophilic enteritis and its differentiation from CEAS. Please pay attention to the following questions and queries, pertaining to your manuscript:

1. According to Line 66, the patient presented with hemoglobin of 2.9 g/dL. This comes in contrast with the line 87, were the blood test analysis on admission revealed Hb 9.7g/dL. Please explain. Was there a red blood transfusion in between?

<u>Answer:</u> As Reviewer 3 pointed out, the patient was referred to our institution after a red blood cell transfusion was performed by the previous physician. This has been described in Lines 65-66.

2. Line 117: please explain why you used montelukast as a monotherapy to reach remission and/or not local corticosteroids, like budesonide?

<u>Answer:</u> Thank you for your suggestion. We performed our initial induction of remission with montelukast monotherapy because the patient's family were steroid phobic. Therefore, we also selected a partial elemental diet as additional treatment. We added this history to Lines 118-119.
