**Scientific Quality:** Grade C (Good)

**Conclusion:** Major revision

**Specific Comments to Authors:**

This paper describes the literature and recent suggestions about the more adequate methods for a good glycemic control in patients with DM and DKD. The authors consider the adequacy of Hb A1c vs glycated albumin, fructosamine and the application of CGM. The review is adequate, although the presentation and style language are susceptible to improvement. I have a MAJOR concern: The authors continuously refer to DKD and not to CKD (Chronic Kidney Disease) in the context of DM. Therefore I have suggested some changes in red colour, on the original pdf. MINOR comments: There are many misspelling along the text. All my suggestions are added in red colour or in added notes on the original pdf, as well as in the table.
