In the manuscript titled "Pancreatic surgery and tertiary pancreatitis services warrant provision for support from a specialist diabetes team", Vasileios K Mavroeidis, et.al discussed the complex associations between diabetes mellitus and pancreatic/periampullary disease in the context of pancreatic surgery and overall management of complex pancreatitis, highlighting the consequential needs and the indispensable role of specialist diabetes teams in support of tertiary pancreatic services. This study has good clinical reference value. However, There are still some minor problems in the article. Therefore, MINOR revision has to be done so the manuscript could be accepted for publication in the the World Journal of Diabetes.

Maior comments : 1 The current manuscript needs to be polished by a native English speaker or a professional language editing service. 2 The format of the references is not uniform.
