**1.Comment:** This is an excellent manuscript. The use of gelfoam injected at the end of the procedure through the needle appears to prevent bleeding from the spleen. Have the authors done more cases?

**1.Reply:** Thank the reviewer's affirmation. Ultrasound-guided coaxial core needle biopsy for the diagnosis of multiple splenic lesions is rarely performed clinically. So far this year, our hospital have done fewer than 10 cases.
