Figure 1 has been drawn about the effects of external factors such as obesity on gut microbiota growth. Please clear shortly about the indirect and direct effects of external factors on the microbiota.

- the mechanism about obesity, microbiome and oncogenesis has been described in the manuscript (new citations added).

In conclusion part, the authors explain three mechanisms that contribute to carcinogenesis. Which one is related to the autoimmune mechanism?

- bacterial overgrowth, bacterial dysbiosis and onco biome were added as a possible forth mechanism. To the manuscript were also added that chronic inflammation and onco biome could be related with autoimmune mechanism.
