- (1) The word "interestingly" was taken away from the edited version of the manuscript
- (2) The published data on how pluripotent human stem cells, other than human embryonic stem cells, respond to genotoxic stresses are surprisingly scarce. Indeed, we found only one reference published in Pubmed concerning the responses of other types of pluripotent human cells, such as, for example, induced pluripotent stem cells to genotoxic stresses; and we discussed and included it in our mini-review. Therefore, we believe it is legitimate to keep the title of our paper as it is now, and not to narrow it down to exclusively hESCs.
