Nice case report but it needs a great deal of Language polishing. Consider also boiling it down, you are repeating yourself several times. In the table you are introducing mm regarding gastrostoma, but you are referring to Fr (not mm) when it comes to the dilatation of the gastrostoma - be consistent.

Answer #2

The unit of gastrostoma diameter used mm only.

Review #3 (Reviewer's code: 01799104)

This is an interesting and rare case. One minor concern is can the 2nd ca be resected simultaneously while performing the reconstruction.

Answer #3

It is necessary to know the pathology diagnosis before reconstruction whether the remaining gastric cancer needs lymph node dissection. The stomach can be used for reconstruction if the dissection does not need. Therefore, the resection of remaining gastric cancer and the reconstruction is not recommended simultaneously.
