As there is considerable heterogeneity with the outcome measures of magnets used within the endoscopy setting, which are not all objectively measurable, it is not possible to meta-analyze or provide a reliable statistical outcome on its utility. However, a reference has been made to Chen et al's paper on magnetic endoscopic imaging v standard colonoscopy an excellent review already published in world Journal of Gastroenterology. This article is easily accessible to those who would wish to read more about the subject.
