

1) Page 2 Line 24-29 and Page 3 Line 1-2 are not about "Chief complaints and history of past illness ", but "Laboratory examination".

This specific paragraph mentioned by the reviewer has been appropriately incorporated into the section of "Laboratory examination".

2) One of the differential diagnosis of symptom "altered mental status and non-vertiginous dizziness" would be hepatic encephalopathy. How was the level of ammonia?

We did check the ammonia level. It was elevated (101 $\mu\text{mol/L}$ [16-60 $\mu\text{mol/L}$]). And the value has been added to the manuscript. We do agree that patient might develop hepatic encephalopathy which contributed to his altered mental status on admission. This is one of the reasons why we classified his hepatic function as Child-Pugh stage C. After all, NICTH should still be the primary diagnosis as patient showed temporary improvement of his mental status when the acute hypoglycemia resolved.

3) Ref 30 is not about "emerging drugs that directly inhibit the IGF signals (PI3K-AKT-TOR or RAF-MEK-ERK) ". Please cite the original article.

4) Fig.1 The quality of the figure is not good enough. Is this arterial phase?
