1) The underlying mechanism of how it functions is not mentioned. A brief discussion should be added in the revised manuscript.

In the manuscript I have described the pathophysiology of NAFLD and within the endoscopy/surgical section I have mentioned how weight loss is achieved I.E Restrictive or malabsorptive. I have now added an additional section briefly describing how weight loss is achieved under the section of bariatric surgery and NAFLD.

2) The source of Table 1, which is recreated from [26], but the context is from DOI:10.1159/000447277; (Corpus ID: 6606524)?

As mentioned, the context of the table is from [26] however we have recreated the table to a more simplified version in keeping with [66].

3) Checking all the abbreviations in the manuscript, some are missing, and some show multiple times, such as laparoscopic sleeve gastrectomy (LSG) and HbA1c.

I have been through all of the abbreviations and hopefully this has now been corrected.

4) Why are only three potential drugs for NAFLD, are they the most promising therapeutics?

I have specifically chosen these three medications as they are promising. Although there are other drugs currently under trials these medications are in phase II clinical trials and I did not feel the need to mention more. Alternatively, if you feel it is more sensible to remove this section I can do so. I have tried to explain why I have chosen these.

5) Please check small details, such as 95%cl or Cl, which should be CI, (confidence interval)
