Reviewer comment: "I would only suggest to trim the Manuscript in order to make it a bit shorter.

Thank you for your constructive recommendation. We struggled to make the manuscript shorter but we felt that we could not take out any part especially from the Materials & Methods nor from the Discussion as we thought that 1) the reader would have difficulty in understanding the methodology and 2) that the relevant literature is so limited and with contradicting results that we had to give a thorough interpretation of all the results of this study that could serve as a baseline for future studies. If you could recommend us which specific parts you think should be taken out, we would be happy to follow your recommendation.

Appropriate changes in numbering of the old references 13 and 14 were made.

According to the updated reference (14) appropriate change of the term "probable UIP" to

“possible UIP” was made throughout the manuscript.
