Dear author, The paper represents a case report with the use of high-speed rotational atherectomy (HSRA) in a case of a fracture trapped corsair tip that was impeding coronary flow causing a ST elevation myocardial infarct. The article is written with the good English-speaking adduction of the arguments. The article is sufficiently novel and very interesting to warrant publication. All the key elements are presented and described clearly. The most discussable options in the article are: 1) I would generally conclude that the case has the optimal structure and does not require the elaboration. But it might be great to have a footage of angio instead of the figures. I would suggest to redraw it having one or two schematic figures with the main steps and the main text or supplementary video. I also would strongly suggest to have a scheme showing what was done. The proper description of the technique plays a major role.
